Syllabus

A syllabus containing the condensed version of the presented workshops will be included in the registration fee.

Concept

The 20 different workshops will discuss the medical imaging approach to the diagnosis of Diseases of the Abdomen and Pelvis. Furthermore, interventional techniques will be discussed. The instruction will be in groups of about 50 participants which rotate through all 20 workshops. Each class room is equipped with a sufficient number of computers, on which individual viewing of the cases in small groups of three participants is possible. During workshops, participants study and discuss the case material on the PC. Teachers then guide the participants through the cases, discuss the differential diagnosis, present additional material and ask questions. Teachers can easily be approached during breaks to individually discuss unsolved problems.

Highlight-lectures will accompany the workshops.
