# Call for Abstracts :

Authors are invited to send abstracts electronically as early as possible, before **December** 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011 (absolute deadline) and from this year on, to choose a research group where her/his abstract fits the best.

This is completely new this year because the classic « Joint Meeting » from Thursday afternoon until Friday afternoon is now replaced. The Belgian Week working group (all societies) decided to have in 2012 a **"Plenary Session" on Friday afternoon (14h-16h)**, without any other parallel sessions at this time. Each research group will suggest maximum 1 or 2 of its best abstracts (basic/clinical) to the Plenary Session working group, which will select the papers that will be presented. Thus, only the really best abstracts of the whole Belgian gastroenterology (clinical/basic) will be presented during the Plenary Session on Friday afternoon.

There will also be a **"Translational Research Plenary Session"** (Friday from 16h-17h30) to stimulate the interaction between basic researchers and clinicians. The aim is to have an excellent state of the art lecture on a basic topic, followed by some basic abstracts and followed by a wrap up of the session with the link to the clinic.

So the abstracts can be sent to the following research groups: Liver and Transplantation (BASL/BLIC), IBD, Endoscopy (BSGIE/Small Bowel Group), Pathology, Paediatrics, Radiology/Nuclear Medicine, Oncology (BGDO), OGFWO, Nutrition, Pancreas and Varia.

The abstracts will be selected by the selection committee of each research group. All abstracts will be scored anonymously from 0 to 10, on the basis of originality and scientific value. A member of the selection committee will not vote if she/he is author or co-author of the abstract.

#### Awards:

- Plenary sessions: 2 awards for the best oral presentations in Basic Research and in
  Clinical Research: awarded on Saturday.
- BASL session: 2 awards for the best Basic and Clinical presentation: awarded on Thursday noon.
- BGDO, Belgian IBD Research Club (BIRD) and the BeSPGHAN (pediatricians) will all grant 1 award on Saturday for the best presentation in their field.
- A Best Poster Award will be granted on Saturday.

An abstract submitted for the Digestive Disease Week (DDW) in May 2011 or the

United European Gastroenterology Week 2011 (UEGW) may be presented at the Belgian Week of Gastroenterology ("National Meeting"), following the rules of the American Gastroenterological Association (AGA) and the United European Gastroenterology Federation (UEGF).

The accepted abstracts (oral/poster) of the 24th Belgian Week of Gastroenterology will be published in Acta Gastroenterologica Belgica (AGEB 2012, fasc1). If not accepted as oral or poster presentation, the abstract will NOT be published anymore in AGEB.
